

## **Jamie Liew – Biography**

**Jamie Liew** is an Associate Professor at the Faculty of Law, University of Ottawa (Canada) and an immigration and refugee lawyer called to the Law Society of Ontario (Canada). She has appeared at the Supreme Court of Canada, Federal Court of Appeal, Federal Court of Canada and the Immigration and Refugee Board as well as the Standing Committees in the Parliament of Canada and the Senate in Canada. Jamie is the co-author of the book, "Immigration Law" (with Donald Galloway) published by Irwin Law. Her research focuses on how immigration, refugee and citizenship law marginalizes migrants, often turning to critical legal, race and feminist theories. More recently she is interested in policy efforts to eliminate statelessness.
