TECH TIPS

- Reducing file size when uploading supporting docs
 - When uploading supporting documents, they cannot be more than 4MB in size.
 - For PDF files:
 - Open file
 - Go to **File** menu
 - Go to **Save File As Other...**
 - Go to **Reduce File Size PDF...**
 - Select **Retain Existing** from the Make compatible within option then click OK
 - Save file where you can find it again. The program will save the file as a reduced size for you
 - If the file size is still too big, try printing and rescanning as black and white and or lower the resolution (dpi) on your scanner
- **Optional Documents** up load field
 - This is where we usually upload our submission letter.
 - When uploading documents for the ITA there is a field called **Optional Documents**. For some reason this field does not always show up. If this happens, refreshing the page sometimes helps or start uploading other documents and eventually this field shows up.
 - When the **Optional Documents** appears, upload a place holder document. Once a document has been uploaded, the field will always be there.
 - Be sure to replace with “place holder document” with your final submission letter.
